The authors set a stage for the research effectively , but it can be improved by providing more specific details about the challenges faced by foreigners in land ownership in Indonesia and by clarifying the research objectives and significance. Additionally, ensure proper citations and a clear structure for the paper.

- 1. Explicitly state the research gap or problem that the study addresses . What is the specific issue or question you are trying to answer in your research ? This should be clearly articulated to provide context for the reader.
- 2. The methodology section is well -structured and provides a clear explanation of the research methods used. However, consider using subheadings to break down the different research methods you employed, such as "Data Collection "and "Data Analysis," to make it even more organized and reader-friendly. You've justified your choice of qualitative research methods, which is appropriate for your research objective. However, you might want to briefly explain why you chose content analysis as the specific analytical method for your study. What advantages does it offer in the context of your research?
- 3. While you've mentioned some limitations of your research in the results section, it's a good practice to also include limitations in the methodology section. This helps readers understand the potential shortcomings of your approach right from the beginning.
- 4. The results section is well-organized, with subsections that help readers navigate through the findings. This makes it easier for readers to locate specific information within the results. As discuss different laws and regulations related to land ownership for foreigners, consider providing citations for these legal documents or regulations. This will add credibility to your findings and allow readers to verify

the information if needed.

The manuscript and ownership in Indonesia for foreign citizens is a well written and timely addressed topic. However, it could be more concise with following suggestion.

- You mention that "the legal framework poses numerous regulatory barriers for foreigners,"but it would be helpful to provide specific examples or key findings from your research in the abstract.
- 2. The introduction provides some historical background on Indonesian land ownership laws , which is useful. However, you could enhance it by briefly explaining the specific challenges or issues that foreigners face when trying to own land in Indonesia. This would give readers a clearer understanding of the problem your research aims to address.
- 3. Explicitly state the objectives or goals of your research in the introduction. What are you trying to achieve with this study? This will help set the context for the reader.
- 4. When referencing prior research or laws, make sure to include proper citations (e.g., APA, A) to give credit to the original sources and to provide readers with the opportunity to explore these references if they want more detail.
- The transition from the historical background to the present situation could be smoother
  . Consider using transitional phrases or sentences to guide the reader from one point to
  another.
