- 1. While the abstract is informative, it could benefit from a slightly clearer structure to make it easier for readers to grasp the key aspects of your study quickly.
- 2. Ensure that the keywords listed at the end of the abstract are reflective of the key concepts and terms discussed in your study.
- 3. You mention that your study aims to examine dispute resolution clauses, but it would be helpful to specify what kind of agreements these clauses are typically found in. Are you focusing on commercial contracts, legal documents, or a broader range of agreements? Clarifying this in the abstract would provide more context.
